Dear Parent/Carer,

A very good afternoon to you, as always I hope you and your families are well. We appear to be moving into the second phase of this situation and many more are venturing out to work and being able to spend more time out in the open air enjoying time to exercise and generally relax. A reminder that we continue to offer schooling for those that fit either the vulnerable or Key Worker category, this provision will now be located back at the school. As mentioned last week, we are not expecting students to complete school work during half term, indeed we recommend they have a complete break from school. It is perhaps a time to take stock of the remote learning that has taken place, ensure everyone has the right resources, perhaps tidy up work spaces and get things in order for the final half term. For those with children in Year 10, I will be in touch on Monday with further details of our gradual return to school, which will begin after half term. The likely starting week is the week beginning Monday 8th June, but we are still awaiting guidance which is expected on the 28th May 2020.

To provide some reassurance to all families, we are working hard to ensure we have excellent procedures and protocols in place, we are working very closely with the Trust and our partner schools and we feel strongly that we are doing all that we can to provide the right environment both in and out of school for our students at this most challenging time.
