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### Extended Learning Opportunities

**Subject:** Textiles

**Year:** 9

**Term:** Autumn 1, Autumn 2, Spring 1.

**Topic:** Creating a 'nature themed' clutch bag.

#### **Learning Objectives**

##### **Autumn 1:**

- To explain, clearly, why it is important to stay safe in the Textiles classroom.
- To research and analyse the work of Josef Frank.
- To take 30 well framed photos, following the theme 'the beauty in nature'.
- To create an exciting mood board showing off your inspiration.
- To create a large, very detailed drawing using your inspiration as a guide.

##### **Autumn 2:**

- To design a bag according to the theme 'the beauty in nature'.
- To create a visualisation of your bag using Photoshop.
- To safely create a heat press sample, embellishing into it as necessary.
- To construct your clutch bag.
- To critically evaluate the creation of your clutch bag.

#### **Extended Learning Opportunities**

- Visit Kew Gardens and create 15 drawings of natural forms.
- Create digital drawings, using a drawing app on your phone, or Photoshop, of 'natural forms'.
- Create one large drawing on A2 paper and one tiny drawing on A6 paper of natural forms.
- Create a stitch sampler, using 5 different stitches.
- Visit a fashion show and write 500 words on how it inspired you.
- Identify the fabric that clothes are made of next time you go shopping.
- Watch The Great British Sewing Bee on BBC 2 or on the BBC iPlayer.
- Use YouTube tutorials to learn how to crochet.
